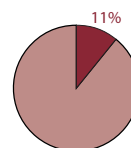

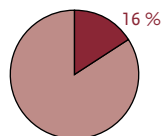

Number of local units in the Brussels-Capital Region in percentage of total number of local units in Belgium in 2008

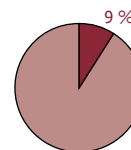


Number of salaried workers employed in the Brussels-Capital Region in percentage of total number of salaried workers employed in Belgium in 2008

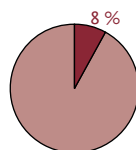


Self-employed workers with residence in the BCR in % of the total self-employed workers in Belgium in 2009

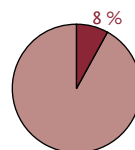

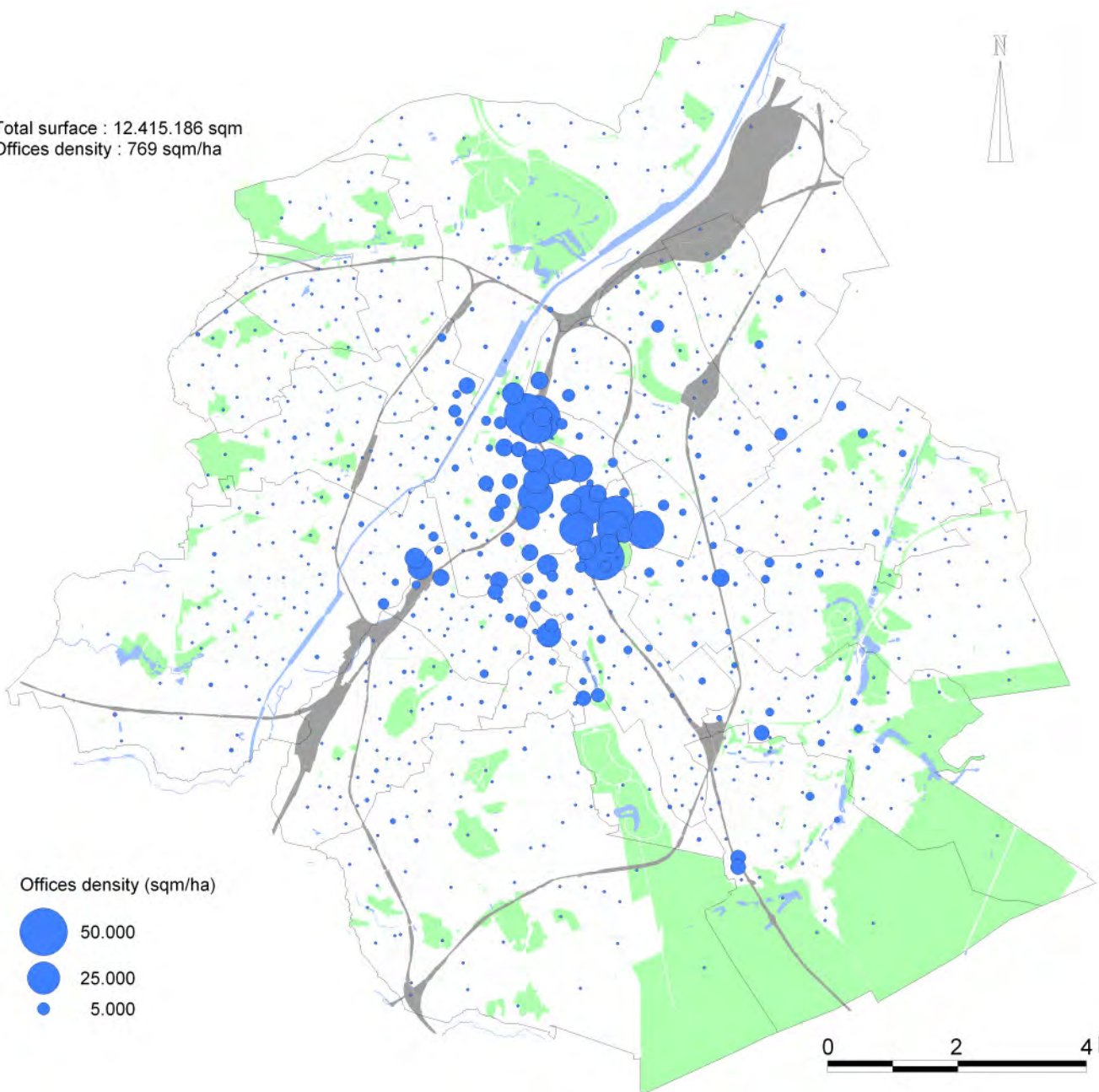


Total net taxable income in the BCR in percentage of the net taxable income in Belgium for the fiscal year 2008

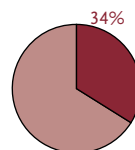
