





Total population of Brussels-Capital Region in percentage of the total population of Belgium in 2008






Foreign population of Brussels-Capital Region in percentage of the foreign population of Belgium in 2008







Number of local units in the Brussels-Capital Region in percentage of total number of local units in Belgium in 2008




Number of salaried workers employed in the Brussels-Capital Region in percentage of total number of salaried workers employed in Belgium in 2008




Self-employed workers

in Belgium in 2009




Total net taxable income

fiscal year 2008





Collected personal income tax in




